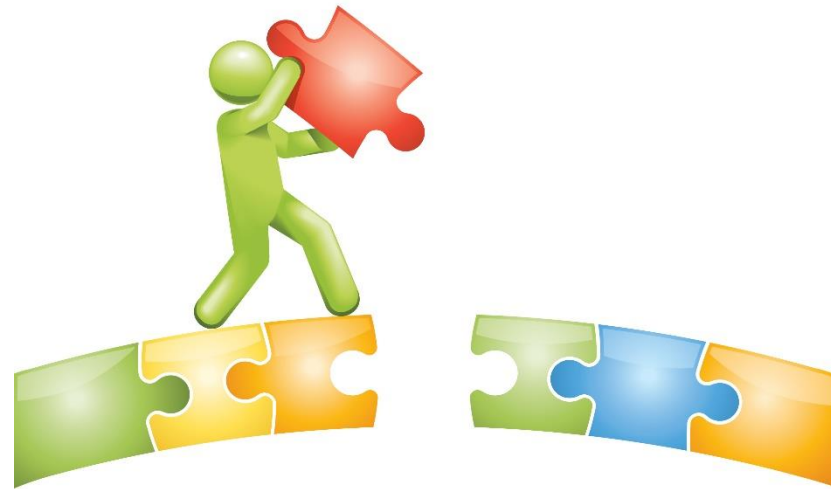

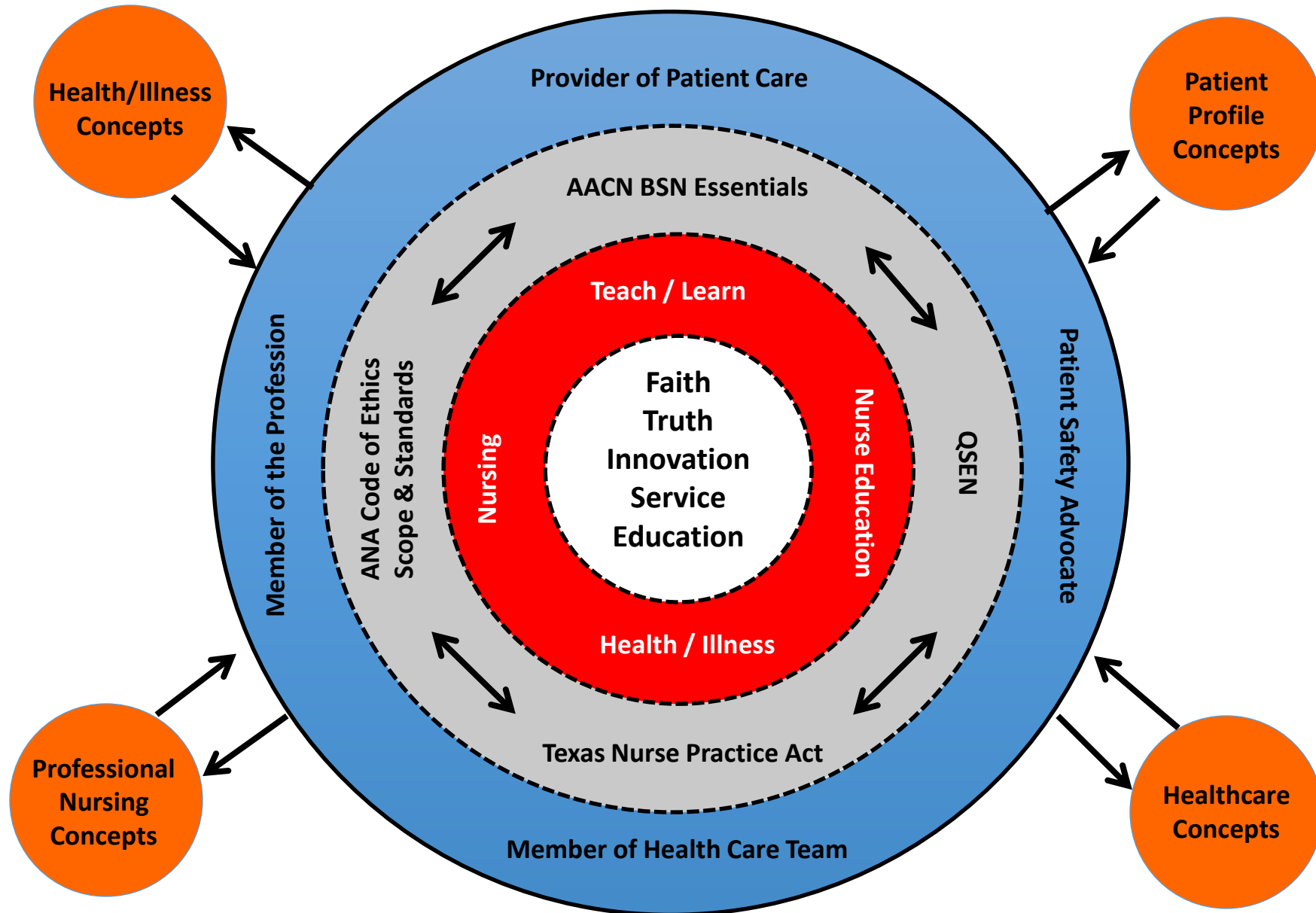

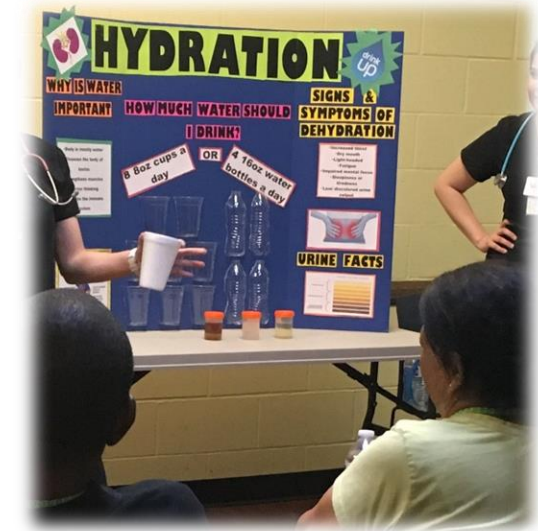


Ila Faye Miller School of Nursing BSN Conceptual Framework



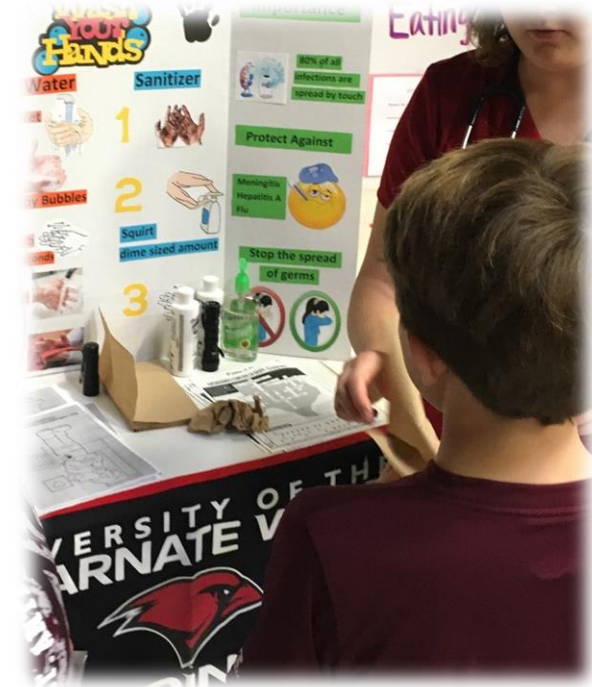
Community First

- ***Population Health in Baccalaureate Nursing Education: Meeting the Challenge (2014 Baccalaureate Education Conference)***
- What? Community before acute?
- Early Focus
 - **Population Health in Level 1**
 - Community health disparities
 - Assessment of healthy individuals and families
 - Primary & Secondary Prevention
 - Clinical sites - community based
 - **Aging, Chronicity, & Care Coordination in Level 2**
 - Secondary & Tertiary Prevention
 - Clinical sites - community based, including rehabilitation



Community Seals the Deal

- **Acute Care Immersion in Level 3**
 - Adult Medical-Surgical Nursing I
 - Psychiatric-Mental Health Nursing
- **Acute Care Specialties in Level 4**
 - Adult Medical-Surgical Nursing II
 - Nursing of Childbearing Families
 - Nursing of Children and Families
- **Return to Community in Level 5**
 - Capstone in Acute or Primary Care Nursing
 - Community Health - Populations



Concepts Connect Community & Traditional Content

- **Community focus**
 - Aligned with the concept based curriculum
 - Strongly supports a broad base of concepts that build in application from health to illness
- **Concepts link....**
 - Early focus on wellness and prevention to alterations in health
 - Understanding the patient experience across environments of care
 - The role of the nurse expanded to full scope of licensure

Bridges: Summary Recommendations

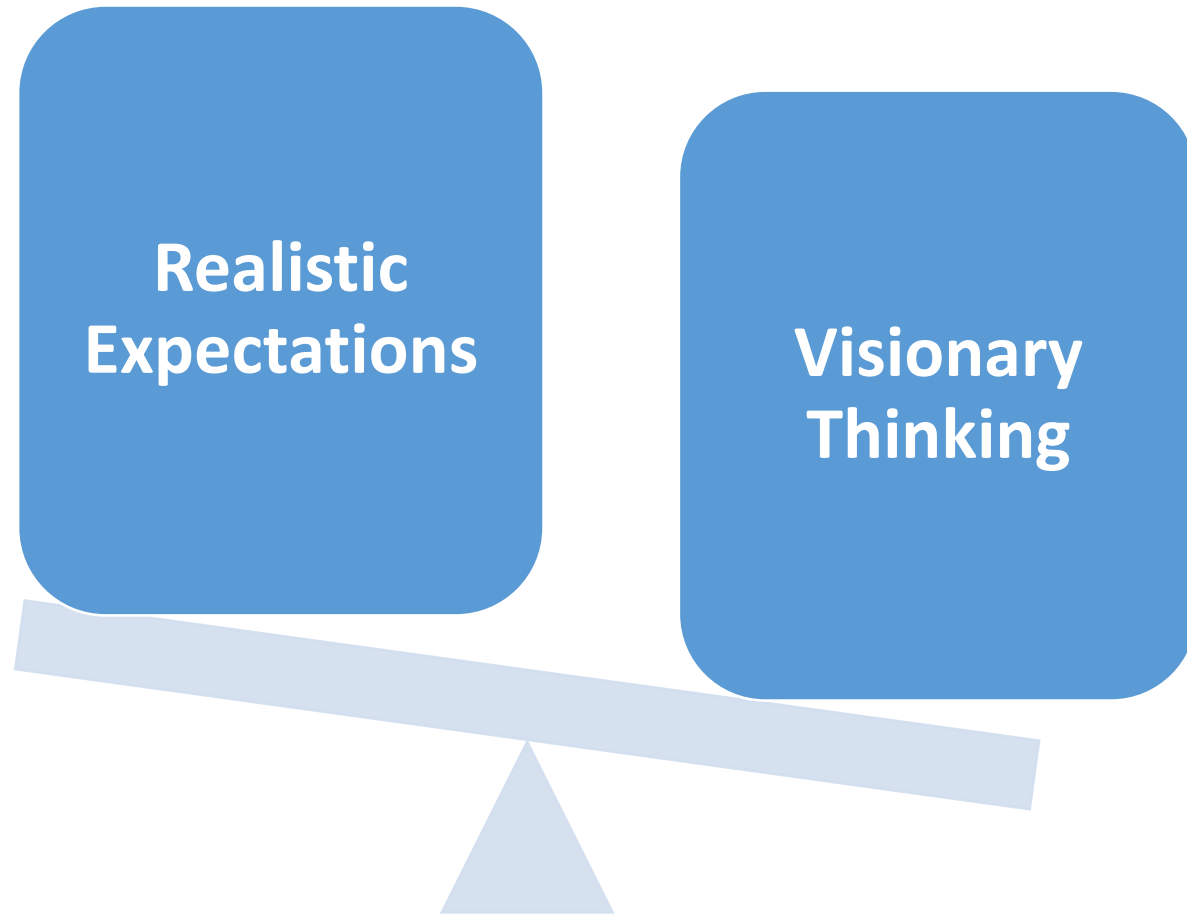


Tolerance of Ambiguity!
