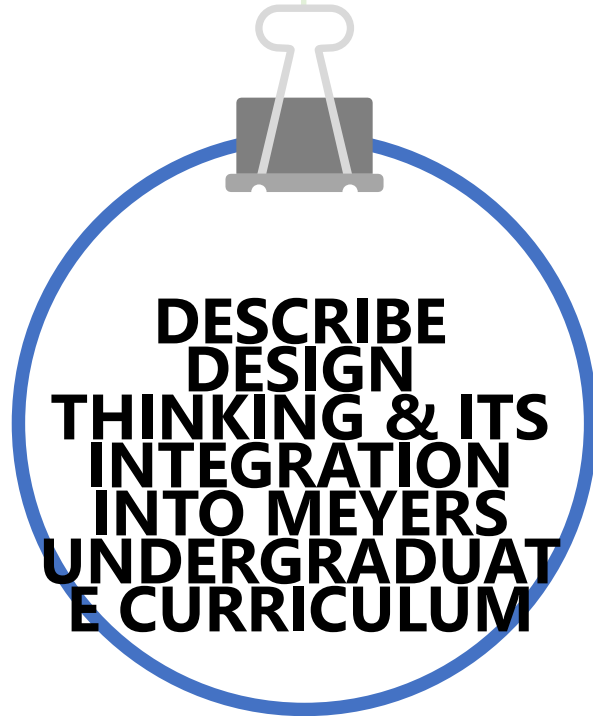
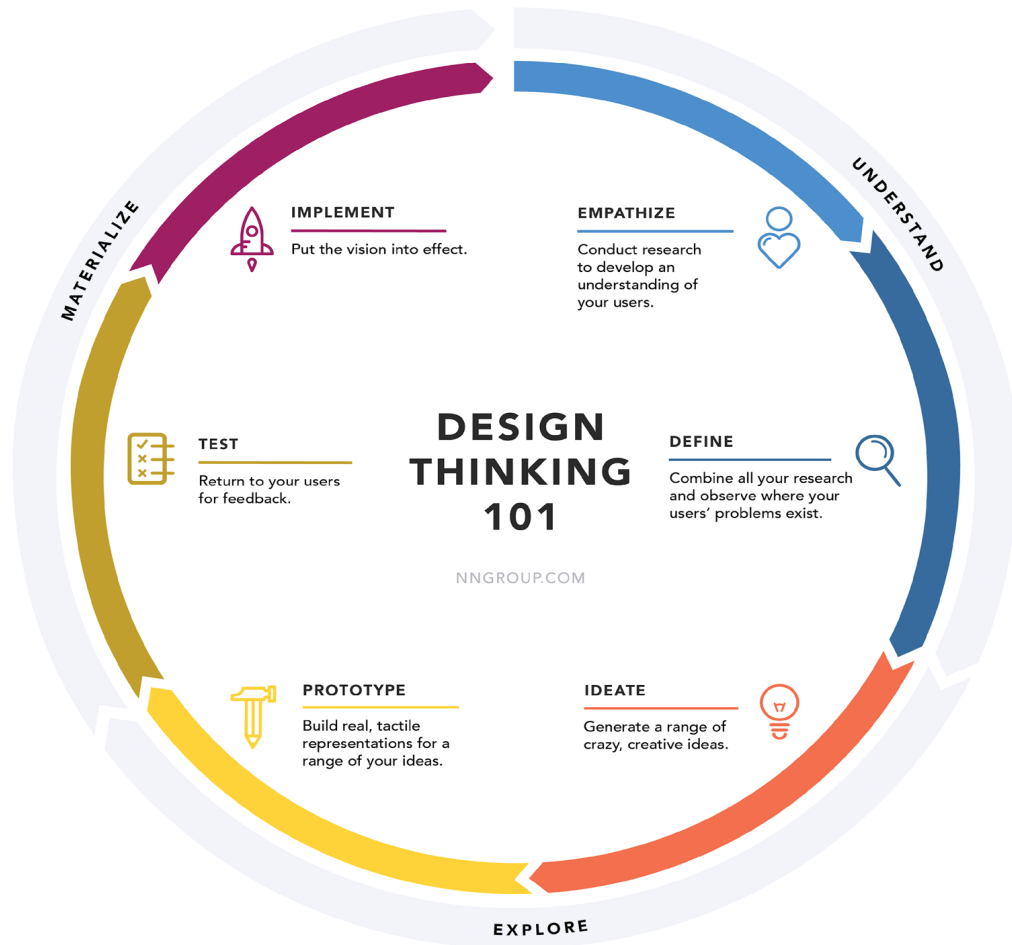

What is Design Thinking?



Step-wise process of applying human-centered design towards problem solving

Rapid prototyping to address complex problems

- ◆ Facilitates understanding of end – user experience
- ◆ The design focuses on end-user feedback throughout all stages of the design and development process

By focusing on the end-user, design thinking facilitates increased end-user experience, satisfaction, and ability to connect and meet human/user needs



Definition of Innovation @Meyers

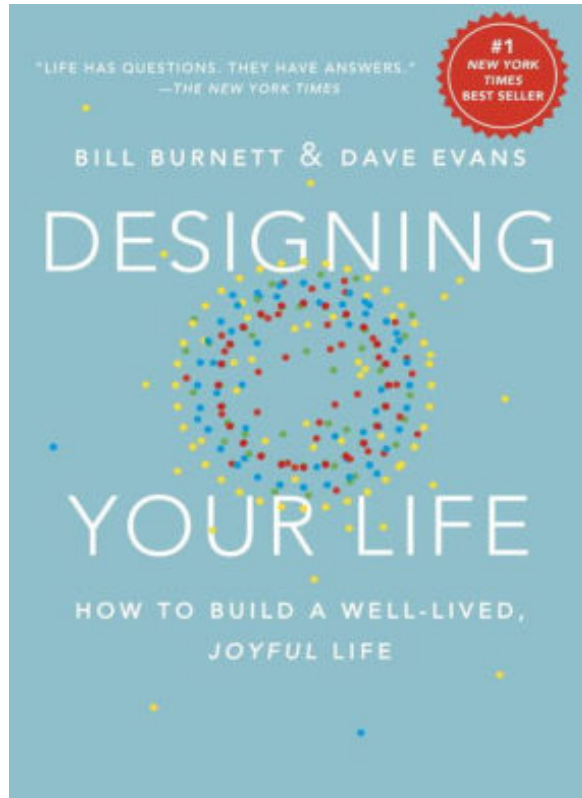

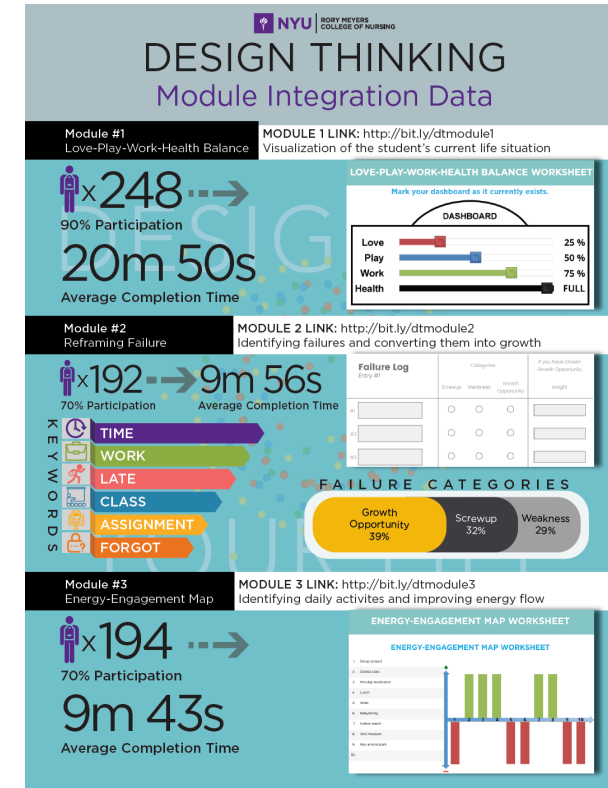

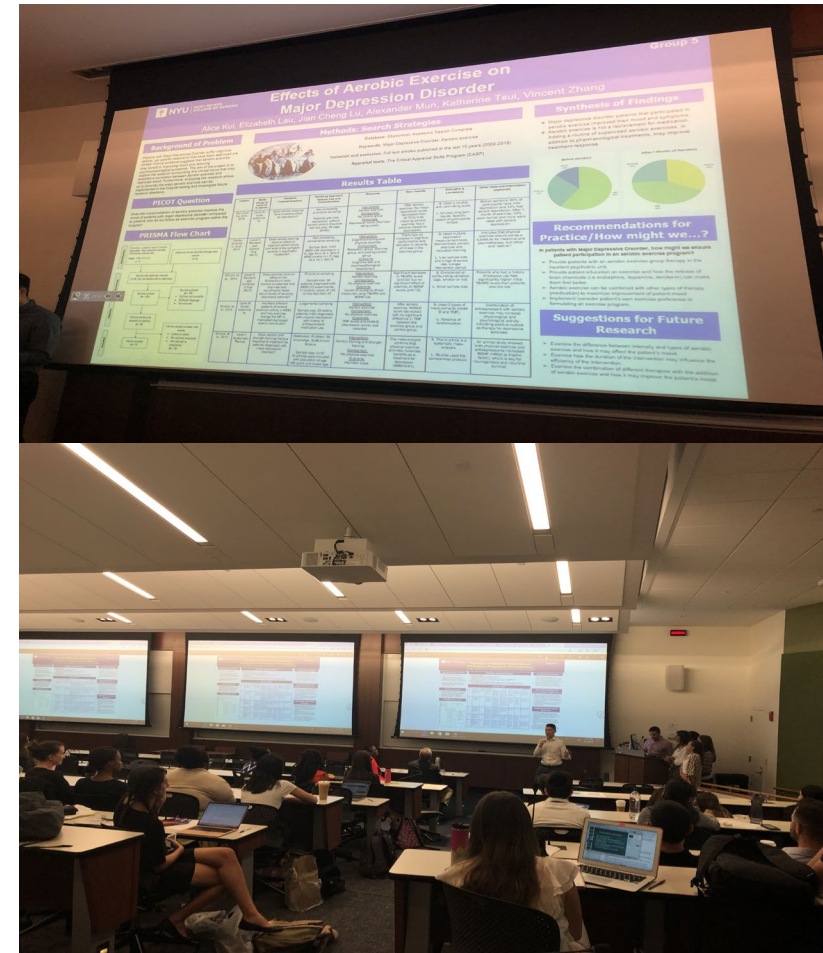


- Adoption of the *The Designing Your Life* (DYL) book as a required text
- Students created a professional online presence and an e-portfolio using a LinkedIn account.

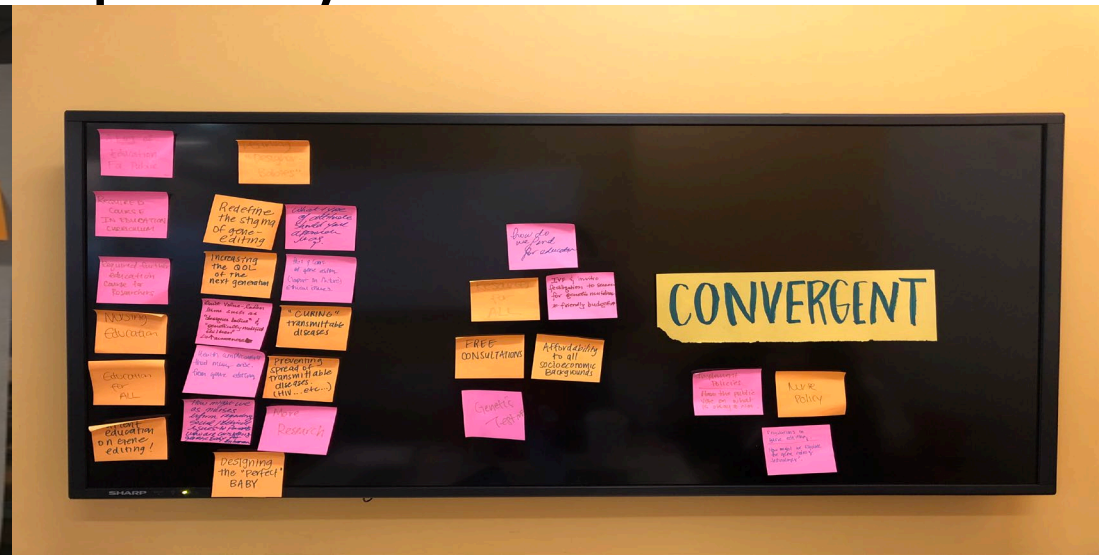
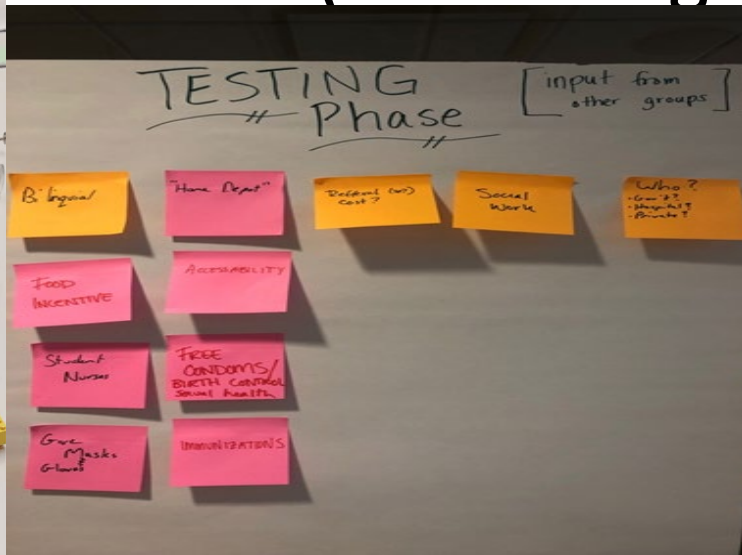
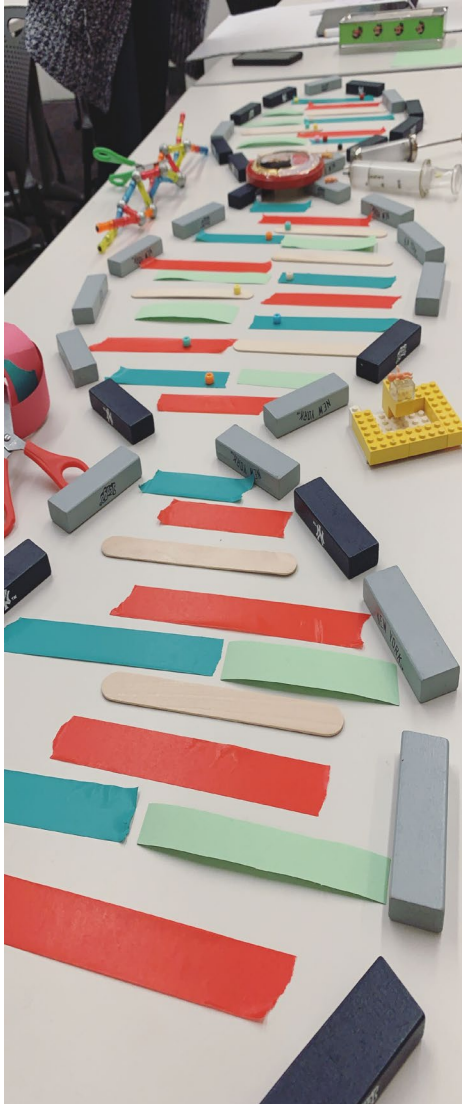


Spring 2019 Translating Evidence into Clinical Practice (2nd Nursing Sequence)

- 44 teams presented their PICOT+How Might We projects via oral presentation at the end of the spring 2019 semester.

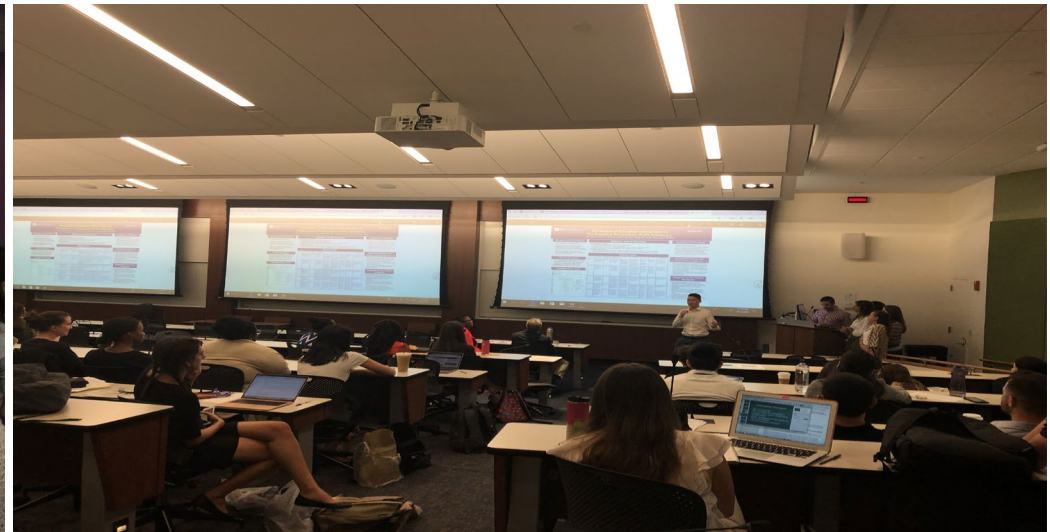


Summer 2019 Contemporary Issues Course (3rd Nursing Sequence)
